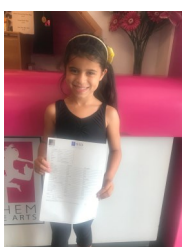

### Green Belt for Ardi!

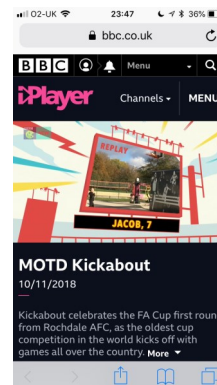
