On Tuesday 20th October, Year 6 enjoyed a virtual Maya day with interactive presentations from Dr Davies, the UK's only expert Maya archaeologist who has been working in the Maya rainforest since 2003. The children learned about how archaeologists gain an understanding about the past from only the material remains and about the magnificent achievements of the Mava in architecture, art, and calendar, astronomy, writing, mathematics and chocolate! The children thoroughly enjoyed a zoom call to Dr Davies giving them an opportunity to ask lots of interesting questions.
