### Welcome Back!

### Google Classroom

By the end of this week, Google Classroom should be set up for all classes from Reception to Year 6. Please get in the habit of checking weekly to see if there are any messages from your child's teacher. From next week, Google Classroom will be used to set homework and work in the event of local lockdown, as well as if your child is off sick (when staff will endeavour to set work as soon as they can), so please familiarise yourself with this, and log on if you have not done so already.

The Government are working on how to give support to families without a device at home. Please let us know if you **do not** have a device that your child can use at home. You **will need** to have access to a BT hotspot. This will mean that, in the event of a local lockdown, we will be ready to place orders should this scheme become more widely available.

### **School Uniform**

Your children look very smart in their uniforms.

As we are participating in more outdoor learning, as well as taking part in the daily mile, to save time please ensure you child wears comfortable black shoes which can be used to run in, or black trainers. Our target is for Bengeo school to 'virtually' travel to Tokyo in time for the 2021 Olympics, a total of 5,918 miles! We will track Bengeo's progress on a map, which all classes will be able to view.

Please limit earrings to small studs and ensure long hair is tied back using a plain hair tie. Watches and Fitbits (used as a watch) are fine to wear, but staff will ask pupils to remove any wristbands or additional jewellery/accessories.

If we have not heard from you by 9:15am, you will receive a message/call from our Attendance Coordinator, Mrs Ogier, to enquire as to why your child is absent.

With regards to holiday absences, we will again be following the local council guidelines which can be found on the Hertsdirect website. Requests for holidays during term times cannot be authorised. Unauthorised absences over 15 sessions, which equates to 7 full days and one half day, per academic year, may result in a penalty notice.

We look forward to working with you on securing excellent attendance for your child.

### **School Dinners**

School dinners are £2.50 for children in KS2. This fee is payable weekly or half termly. Unfortunately we are not able to allow a charge of more than £25.00 to remain unpaid as debts come directly out of the school budget, thereby affecting the educational provision of all pupils. Should this happen, your child will have to revert to packed lunches from home until this amount has been settled.
